MORGAN COUNTY 2-1-1 REPORT

APRIL 2012—MARCH 2013

2-1-1 is available statewide—24/7/365—to connect Hoosiers who need help, OR who want to give help, with community resources. The service is primarily funded by philanthropic dollars. However, a recent state contract to provide SNAP Outreach (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program—formerly known as Food Stamps) has allowed the Indiana 2-1-1 Partnership to expand 2-1-1 services to all 92 counties.

Currently, there are 13 Indiana 2-1-1 Centers.

Connect2Help is the largest center, providing 2-1-1 coverage to 24 counties and after-hours coverage for most of the rest of the state.

The following report provides a comparison of Morgan County and the entire Connect2Help service area. Every community has strengths and weaknesses. Identification of each is the first step to improving the community's quality of life. Connect2Help is eager to be part of this community conversation by sharing information about the needs and resources in Morgan County.
